STATUS: High rates of relapse and overdoses during Covid across the US and Arkansas

- Latest CDC provisional data estimates:
 - Overdoses up 29% across the US between 8/2019 and 9/2020 vs previous 12 months
- We are aware of 15+ suspected overdose deaths in NWA this quarter






Speakup About Drugs Coalition of America 52m - 3

- SAD is included in HCR1002
- Gina and Dan Schneider testified at the Arkansas Legislature for HB29 which would have made trafficking of Fentanyl a capitol offense.
 - Bill was denied.
 - Other Fentanyl bills across the country were denied during the 2021 Legislative sessions.
 - We will look for other bill sponsors in the next session and use the learnings to re-work Bills.

We saw 525 locationbased clicks on the Speak Up About Drugs ad sets.


The radio campaign warns of the dangers of Fentanyl and was timely given the sharp increase in reported overdoses as a direct result of Fentanyl.
